GOLF COURSE:

As winter descends upon us here at Goose, my team and I will be embarking upon our winter program. We have started by clearing out the area located in front of the parking bays facing the 18th green as you walk down to the driving range.

We have also recently incorporated a new drainage system on the 8th tee box to assist in dealing with the wetness in that area.

Next, we will be addressing the steps on the 8th tee box and replacing them with the same design as on the 3rd.

A few of our staff recently attended a workshop in George, where they were given a better understanding of the game of golf itself as well as golf etiquette. We encourage all of our staff members to attend as many courses as possible to further their education and knowledge of the industry.

This winter we will again be increasing the verti-cutting and dusting on the greens which helps to remove the thatch that has built up over the season and in so doing creates a better putting surface.

:Golf Rules:

I get asked on a regular basis about grounding your club in the bunker, so in this issue of golf rules I will help you understand the rule and put all doubts you may have to rest.

THE NEW RULE:

Under Rules 12.2a and 12.2b, the player will be allowed to touch or move loose impediments in a **bunker** and will be generally allowed to touch the sand with a hand or club.

On top of this, golfers can move loose impediments in bunkers and will not be penalized for generally grounding their club away from their ball. However, you still **CANNOT GROUND** your club when **PLAYING** a **BUNKER** shot. You can still take an unplayable lie from a bunker, should you need to, but with a drop out for two strokes.
