Hi there from the Goose Valley Team

August has been a surprisingly busy month at the club, despite the two weekends of heavy rain. We started with a sold out field for the Charity event – Tee off 4 Tourism, raising over R₃0 000 on the day. The Southern Cape Seniors group had 70 players on the day, they all enjoyed themselves and gave many compliments on the condition of our course.

It's also great to see the clubhouse buzzing again now that everyone can sit and have a drink after their round. We have resumed prize givings again and we aim to conclude the prize giving within 30 minutes of the last cards being handed in.

The Friday meat comps are back again and although we are requesting an attendance prize giving in order to create the vibe after golf as well as support the bar, we understand that during the COVID regulations, we can't force you to stay. Should you not be able to attend prize giving, we will accept and keep your prize if you have given your apologies to the golf shop. A note from our Green Keeper:

This time of the year the course is looking at its best. We have had enough rain to keep the course green and it's just warm enough so that the course doesn't dry out. It's a perfect balance!

Next month we will be hollowtining our greens. You are probably wondering why we do this when the greens are at their best. We want our greens to recover as quickly as possible and this can only happen when they are healthy. Hollowtining unhealthy greens could worsen the greens and the holes will take longer to recover.

At the moment the green speeds are fast. They will however slow down in the next few weeks as we put down more fertilizer and start watering more often.

We have completed a couple of projects over the past few weeks such as the levelling of the Teebox on 11 - this will take a few weeks to grow in before we can play from it again.

We also created a flower bed behind the 2nd green and removed part of the hedge on the 8th Tee to open the Teebox a bit more. Most of our winter work has been completed and we will now start focusing on the detail of the course and getting ready for a busy season.
