

With club champs coming up, I think the best thing to talk about is the mindset and approach to a big event like that. Medal plays games with your mind, so the best advice is to work on course management and try take one shot at a time and not panic if you hit a bad shot. Take your medicine and try get the least shots on the hole, even if that means taking a triple drop. You reset your mind and try hit fairways first, then greens, take your par and run to the next hole. Remember you can't win a club champs in the first 18 but you can certainly loose one..... Good luck to all those playing!!

A note-from our Green Keeper:



Rainfall:

Oct 2019: 35 mm
Oct 2020: 117.5 mm
Jan - Aug 2019: 316.5 mm
Jan - Aug 2020: 570.5 mm

We can slowly feel the season changing and warmer weather is on its way. During October we had 117 mm rain. 70 mm of that came down in a few hours' time. This caused the 7th and 9th to flood for a few days. Luckily we didn't have any major damage to the course.

With all of the rain also came a lot of mosquitos. They soon disappeared as the wind picked up. We do spray chemicals on the dam edges to kill off any mosquito larvae. It is impossible however to kill all of the mosquitos.

While we had all the rain and cool temperatures, we used the time to upgrade our pump system. We also installed a new filter as our water quality is not of the best quality and this is why it is crucial to filter out any solids. We also did some upgrades to our pumps as well as the computer that runs the pumps.

Our Greens have recovered nicely after hollowtining. They are still quite fluffy and slow. We will now start working on the green speeds as all the holes have closed up. We also spray Primo Maxx (slows down the growth) onto the greens and will help to maintain a steady green speed throughout the day. The rest of the course is looking good and we are looking forward to hopefully a busy season.
