A note from our Green Keeper:

Rainfall:

Nov 2019: 69 mm Nov 2020: 38 mm Jan - Aug 2019: 386 mm Jan - Aug 2020: 609 mm

I'm sure you have noticed the small circular dead patches on some of the greens that look like pitch marks. These are called dollar spot and can be seen from early spring to late autumn and is most active when humidity is high and daytime temperatures are between 15°C and 30°C and nights are cool



The disease infects by producing a <u>mycelium</u>, which can be spread mechanically from one area to another. It can also be spread from one golf course to another through spores that are stuck on the bottom of your golf shoes.

Luckily this disease does not affect the grass roots and crown. Although it does cause the greens to be bumpy, it can easily be cured and managed. There are a few ways we can limit the damage caused by dollar spot.

•Less watering

- •Removing dew in the mornings
- •Spraying preventative chemicals
- •Fertilizing more often
- •Verti-cutting and dusting more often.

On older greens it is more difficult to manage diseases as the grass has gotten immune to the chemicals that we spray, so the chemicals have become less effective. Dollar spot will always be a problem when the weather is favourable but can be managed and the damage can be limited. So, the next time you are out there and you see dollar spot on the greens, don't be concerned as we are managing it!
