Handicaps News

January 2021

While there are some differences in the scores that different countries allow for Handicap score entry purposes, there are a few key issues in the system that make all the <u>WHS Handicap Indexes</u> comparable. These are:

1. Net Double Bogey (Net two over par)

All countries now use <u>Net Double Bogey</u> as the maximum score allowed on a hole when calculating the Adjusted Gross Score for a handicap score entry into the system.

This means that, when entering your score for Handicap purposes, the maximum score allowed, and what you have to record for a hole where you 'ring out', is a Net Double Bogey (Net Two Over Par or Zero Stableford Points). If you stroke on a par 4, NETT DOUBLE BOGEY is a 7 OR 7 for zero points. (par 4 is a NETT 3, 5 is a NETT 4, 6 is a NETT 5 and 7 is a NETT double drop) The most simple way is to put down the number/score that you get 0 points.

2. Handicap Differential

All countries use the same calculation for a Handicap Differential that is used to calculate your Handicap Index. A differential is calculated with the following formula: (Adjusted Gross Score – Course Rating) x 113/Slope Rating of the Tee you used. This is the number you see in your scoring record for each round.

3. Average of the best 8 out of the last 20 differentials.

All countries now use an average of the best 8 differentials out of the last 20 to calculate a Handicap Index.

4. WHS Course Rating System

All golf courses are now rated using the same course rating system, to give a <u>Course Rating and a Slope Rating</u>. The Course Rating is the measure of the difficulty of each Tee at a golf course relative to par for a scratch golfer (0-Handicap Index), while the Slope Rating is the relative difficulty of a Tee for a 19-Handicap Index golfer when compared to a scratch golfer).

These four pillars of the World Handicap System ensure that your Handicap Index is valid and equitable at any course, anywhere in the world, that has implemented and is part of the World Handicap System.

Dear Presidents, Unions and Clubs,

Please be advised that it has been agreed by the SAGA and WGSA NEC's that Rule 6.2a (Handicap Allowance) of the Rules of Handicapping (RoH) be implemented in South Africa, effective from 1 March 2021, so as to give golfers of all abilities and handicap levels a fair and equitable chance of winning in competition play.

The implementation of Rule 6.2a, will ensure that South Africa is now aligned with the World Handicap System in the rest of the world.

As of 1 March 2021 the new handicap rule for any betterball comps will have both players playing off <u>85% of their course handicap</u> (which ever tee they choose).

In this month's article I am going to talk about fertilizer. How do we decide what fertilizer to use and how much do we use. Well, first we need to look at what type of grass we are fertilizing. Our greens for example which are Bent Grass, will use different fertilizers to our tees and fairways which are Kikuyu.

We also take soil samples twice a year and send them in to the lab for analysis. This gets broken down and we can see what nutrients we need in the soil. We then work out a program for the year and the next time we do soil samples we can see the results and adjust accordingly.

Grass needs certain nutrients to grow. This can be broken up into two groups.

Macro nutrients: Nitrogen (N), Phosphorus (P), and Potassium (K).

Micro nutrients: boron (B), chlorine

(CI), copper (Cu), iron (Fe), manganese (Mn), molybdenum (Mo), zinc (Zn) and nickel (Ni).

If there is a shortfall or excess of any of these nutrients, it could potentially be harmful to the turf and we could lose or see the greens becoming very unhealthy. This is why it is so important for turf grass managers to know what is going on underneath the soil and use the right fertilizer program to keep the greens and course healthy and in good condition.
